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LAMAMA PRESENTS SAM I AMA as a part of midsumma 2021



When I began to understand the different identities of the Deaf community, I asked myself, who am I? I was drawn to the Deaf community. I wanted to be in that world, I wanted an identity that reflected that. But, I couldn't find one. I'm still unsure if I will find one.

Sam I Am explores the experiences, memories, and unknowns that a gay deaf boy from the inner Western suburbs of Sydney must learn to embrace as he accepts and defines his identity. Set on the eve of his big move to Melbourne, this deeply personal story recounts other pivotal events of Sam's life, including his journey with hearing aids and speech pathology, learning Auslan, and choosing to come out following the 2017 marriage equality plebiscite. Are we truly in control of the person we become, or can we ever outrun the events and choices of our past?

Sam I Am originally played to sold-out houses at Brand X / The Flying Nun in Sydney, and now comes to Melbourne in a new production from Antipodes Theatre Company. Identifying as Queer and Hard of Hearing/Deaf, Sam Martin's art practice explores the intersectionality of identity, including his own, hoping to create discussion and encourage others to do the same. Directed by Dan Graham, this autobiographical journey will incorporate two Auslan interpreters and live captioning at every performance, creating a fully accessible experience.
