Our Fringe Festival program includes an Irish double bill of Afterplay by Brian Friel, featuring Margaret Mills and John Bolton and directed by Kirsten von Bibra, and Samuel Beckett's All That Fall, directed by Melanie Beddie and featuring an all-star cast. Tiffany Barton brings us her brand new Ukrainian Macbeth interpretation, Not All Dictators, and we can't wait for you to experience Hedda GablerGablerGabler - a three-way live art endurance sport.

After many stop/starts due to Covid we are so excited to finally be able to bring you An Indigenous Trilogy - decades in the making - by our First Nations' Producer Glenn Shea.


Then... representing the bulk of our Spring season, La Mama Explorations runs amok in both houses from October 17 until December 18, and includes twenty-eight bite-size deliciously chewy three day seasons.

"This is the first full Exploration season we've had since 2017," said Liz Jones, La Mama Co-CEO and Artistic Director. "Pre-fire. Pre-Covid lockdowns. From 1978 we have relied on this season of small works with big ideas to fill us with new works and challenges for the future. It is a very welcome and exciting return."

If that wasn't enough, La Mamica serves up a spring storm with Musica, Cabaretica and Poetica - growing in popularity each season, these one-night special events will sell like hot cakes.

And finally La Mama Kids will have spring fever with all the many and varied offerings, including band All Day Fritz, and a Bukjeh activation by Aseel Tayah, exploring food, culture, health, and connection with land, with activities for the kids.
