*Cactus* follows Abbie and her best friend PB as they navigate their last year of high school. It's going well. I mean, they're still virgins, but it's going well. Milestones are being met. Exams are drawing near. Freedom is on the horizon. Then Abbie gets some news that suddenly and unceremoniously plunges her into a world she wasn't ready for. In good news for year twelve students, *Cactus* has been selected for the 2023 VCE Theatre Studies Unit 4 Playlist. It's refreshing that students will be given the opportunity to see a work set in a contemporary Australian context, empowering them to relate and reflect on the experiences of characters like themselves on stage.

Nunn has quickly gained a reputation for creating quietly clever original work that isn't afraid to take risks. With nuanced direction from Katie Cawthorne (*Pillow Fight, Hell's Canyon, The Three Graces*) and a cracking creative team including Georgia Heath and Fran Sweeney-Nash Cactus is a new Australian work full of insight and humour.
